October 2, 2023






Figure 3: The Average Price of Gasoline by Region, compared to US Average October 2, 2023







Figure 4: The Average Price of Gasoline by States, compared to US Average October 2, 2023

Figure 5: The Average Price of Gasoline by Cities, compared to US Average October 2, 2023







Figure 6: Top 5 States with Highest Price of Gasoline October 2, 2023

Figure 7: Top 5 Cities with Highest Price of Gasoline October 2, 2023







Figure 8: High, Low, and 2023 Current Week Prices

Figure 9: Change in Gasoline Prices Fall 2023: September 04, 2023 - October 02, 2023







Figure 10: Change in Gasoline Prices Since Record High
