## PRICING STRUCTURE

API's Process Safety Site Assessment Program (PSSAP) provides opportunities for hydrocarbon and chemical processing facilities to promote step changes in process safety performance, learn from shared experiences and subject matter experts, offer feedback on industry performance and trends, and to encourage process safety collaboration.

PSSAP is a not-for-profit industry program administered by API and is a part of the API and American Fuel and Petrochemical Manufacturers (AFPM) collaboration to promote process safety, the Advancing Process Safety Initiative.

Pricing for PSSAP participation is below. For assessments in the contiguous United States, travel and expenses are included. For international assessments and those in AK or HI, airfare costs for the assessors will be recouped in addition to the listed pricing, with no markup or pass-through costs included
