3. Total imports in April 2012 as a percentage of total domestic petroleum deliveries: 55.8 percent (April 2011: 61.3 percent). [API]
4. Persian Gulf petroleum imports in February 2012 as a percentage of total imports: 25.9 percent (February 2011: 18.1 percent). [DOE]
