
## Methodology

Would you like to see America import more or less of the oil it needs from Canada?





Would you like to see America import more or less of the oil it needs from Canada?





Would you like to see America import more or less of the oil it needs from Canada?





Do you support or oppose the building of the Keystone XL pipeline to bring oil from Canada to the U.S.?










































