

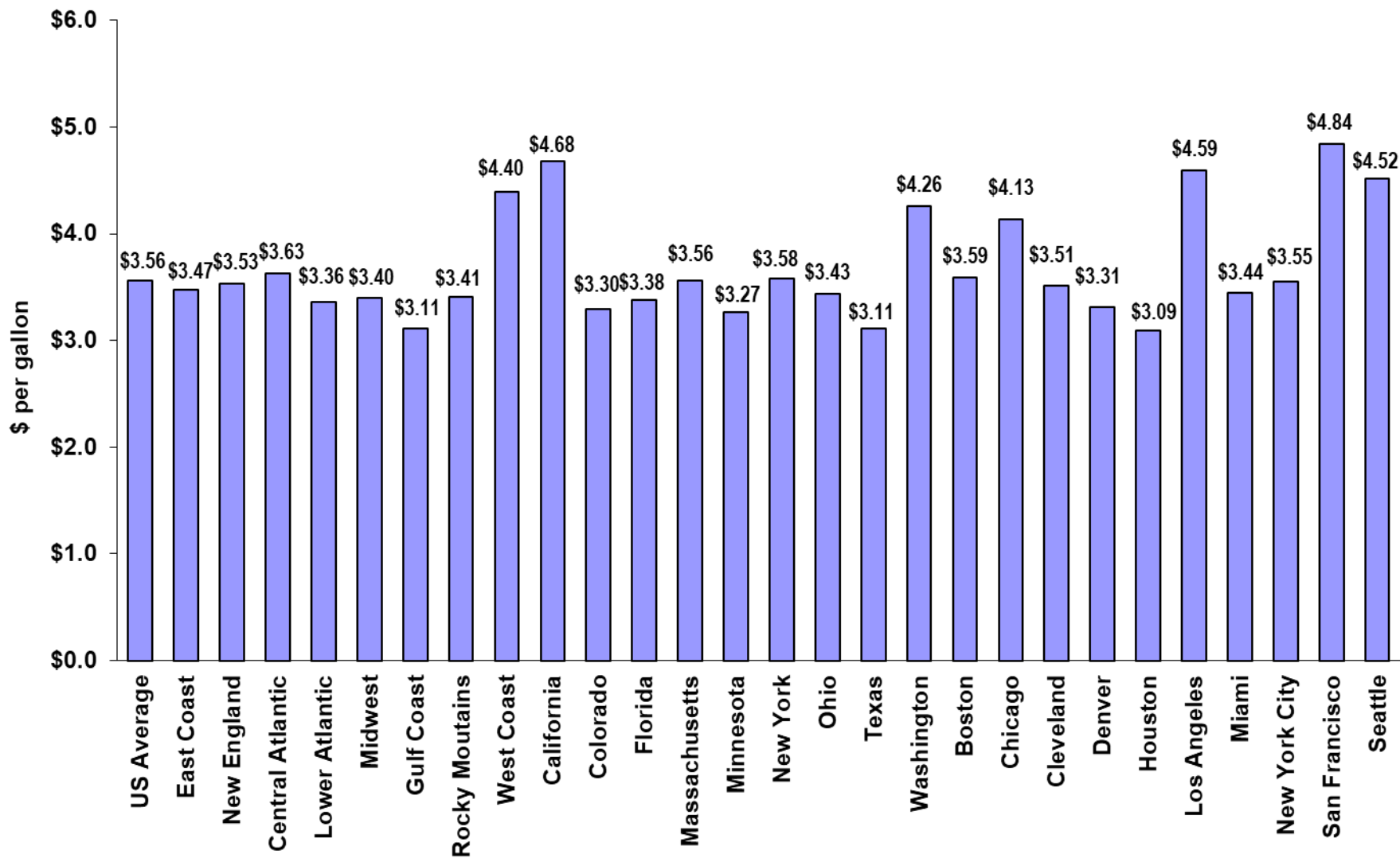
Figure 1: Change in Gasoline Prices (All Grades and Formulations)

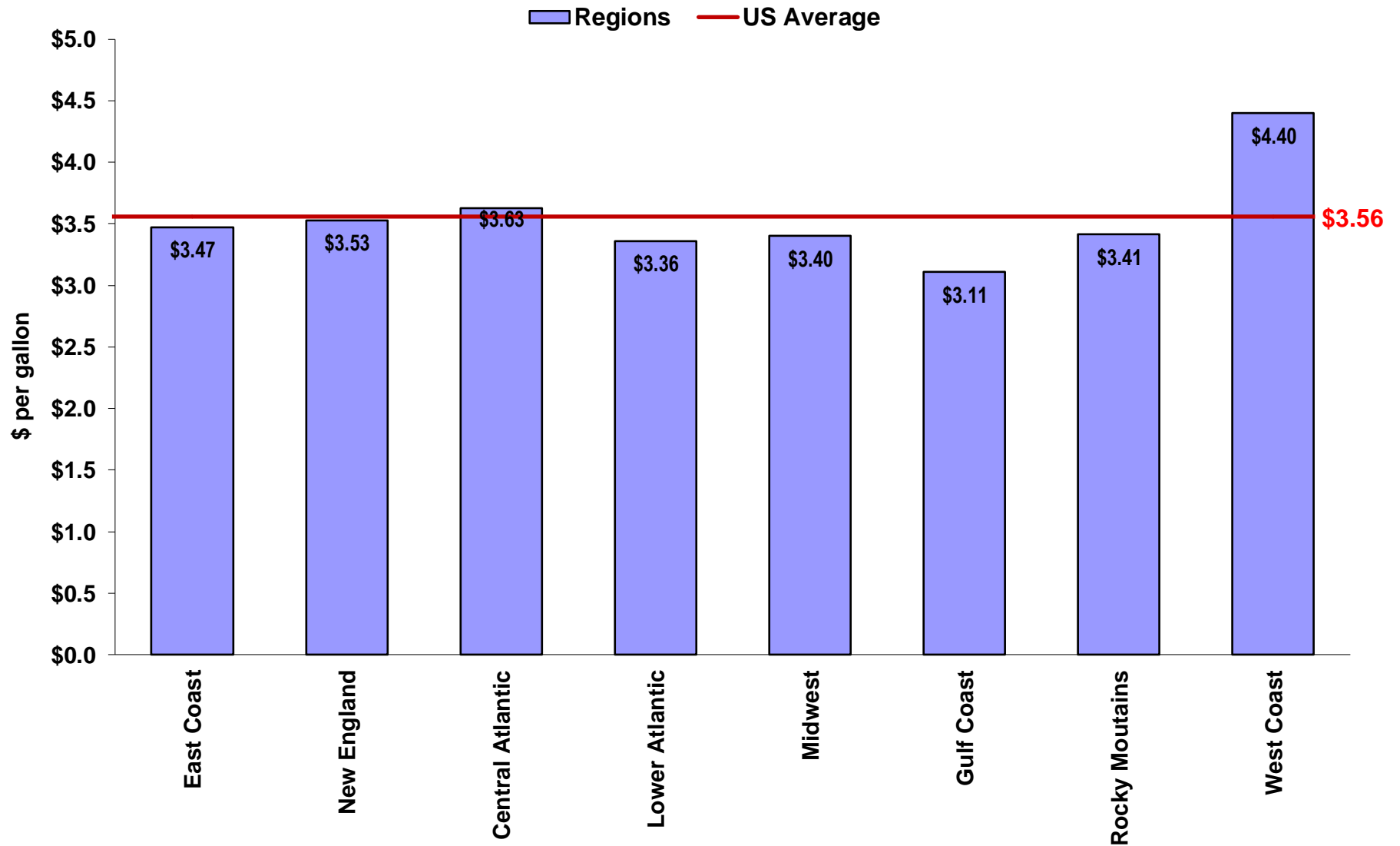
**Figure 2: The Average Price of Gasoline (All Grades and Formulations)

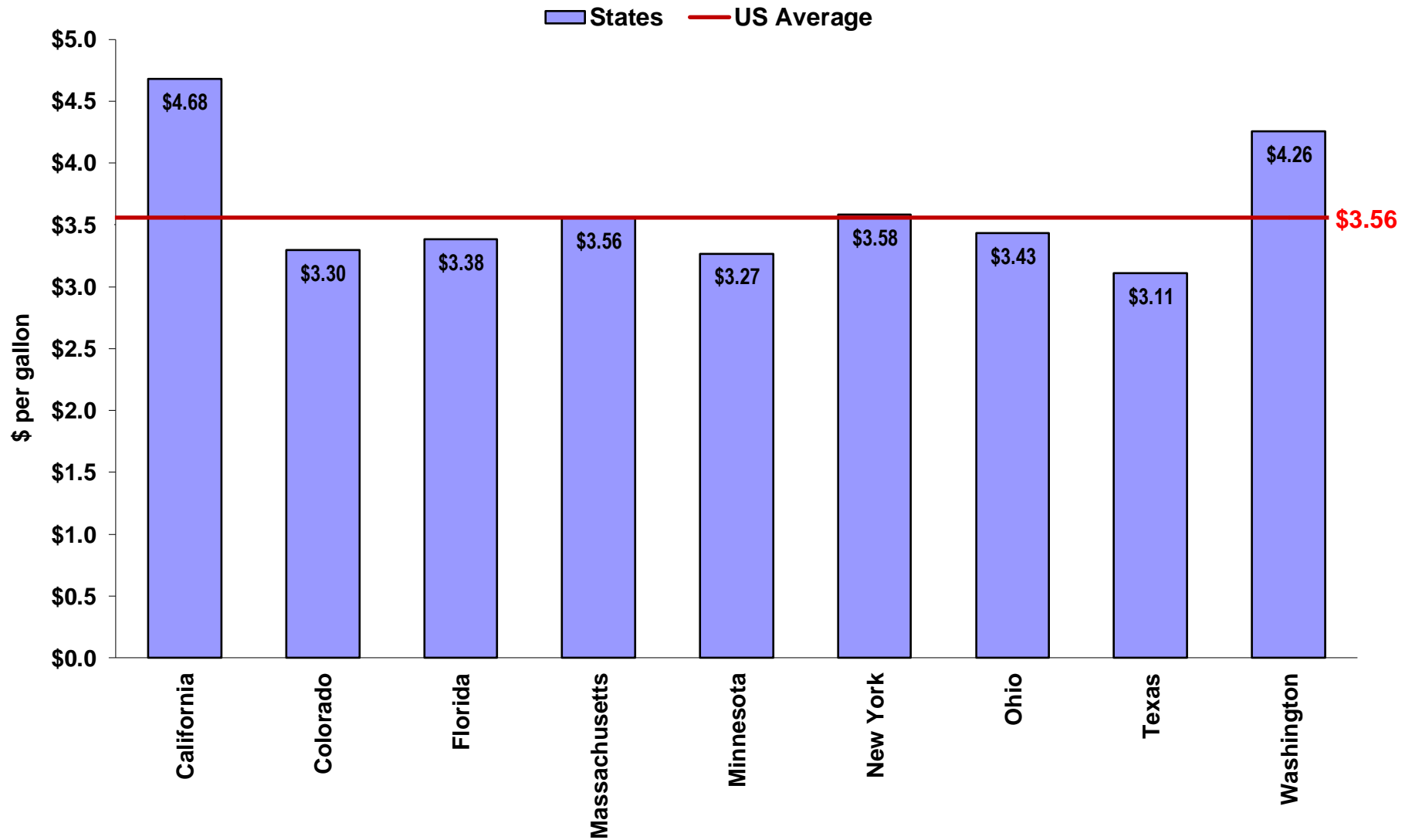
**Figure 3: The Average Price of Gasoline by Region, compared to US Average

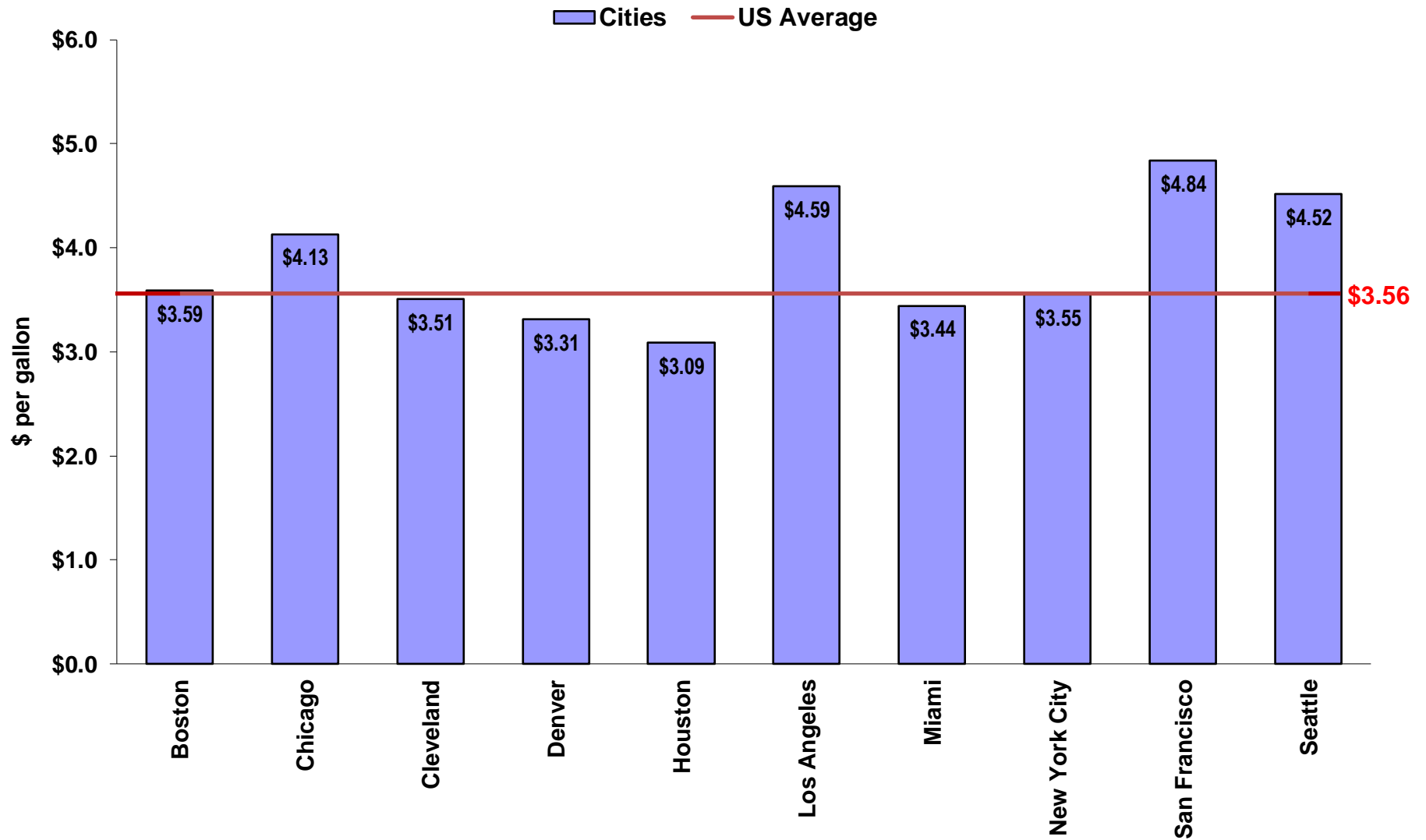
**Figure 4: The Average Price of Gasoline by States, compared to US Average

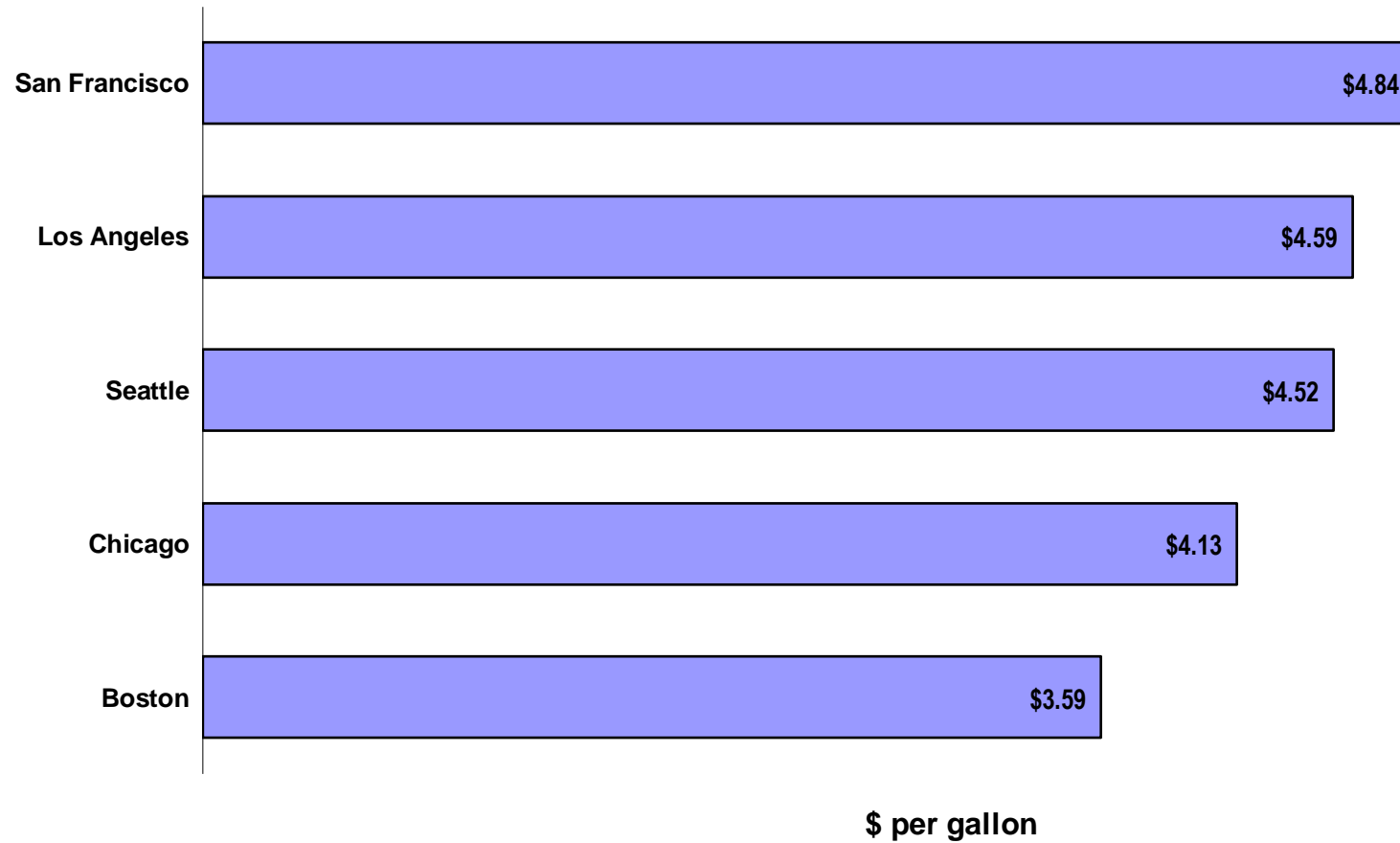
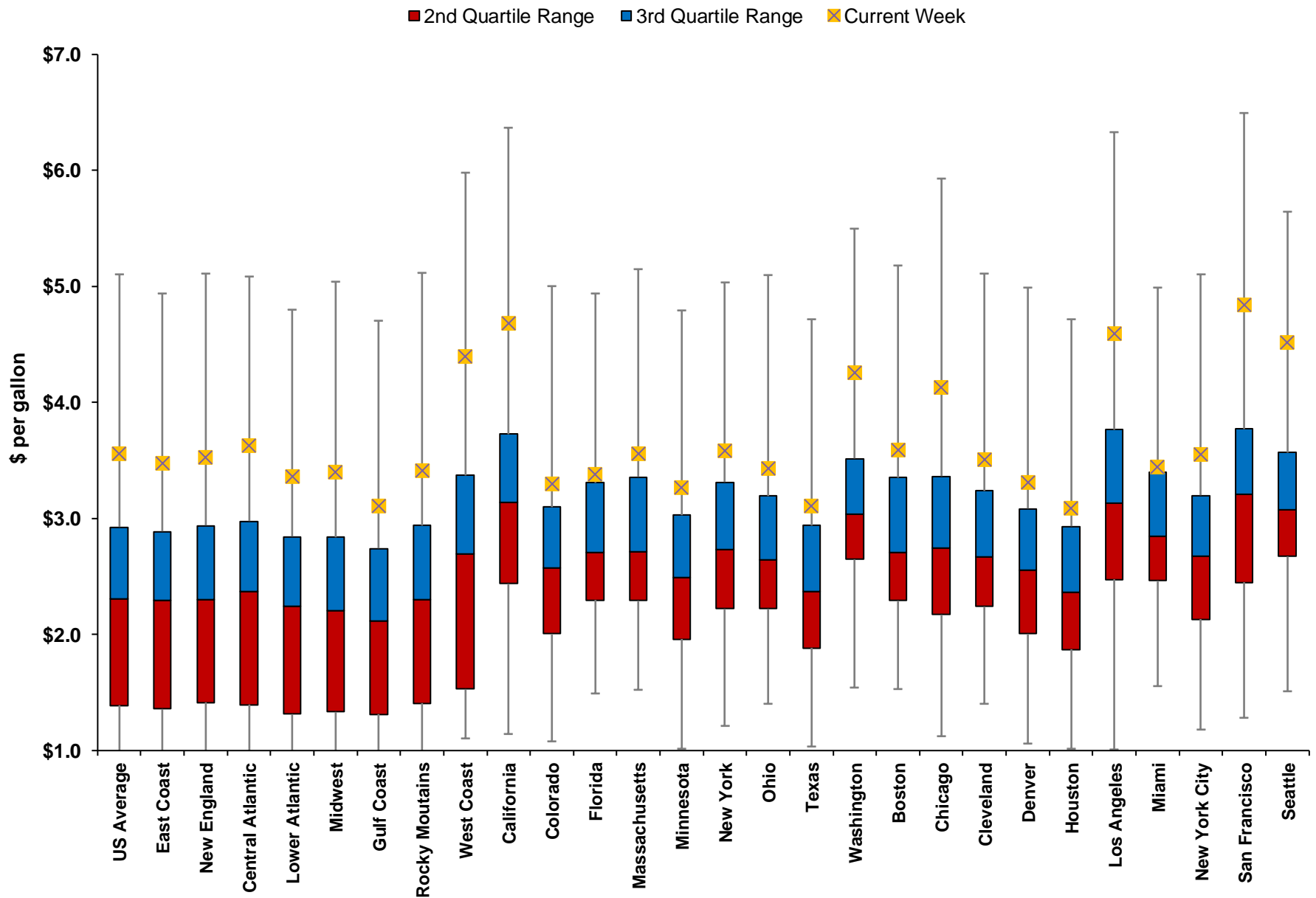


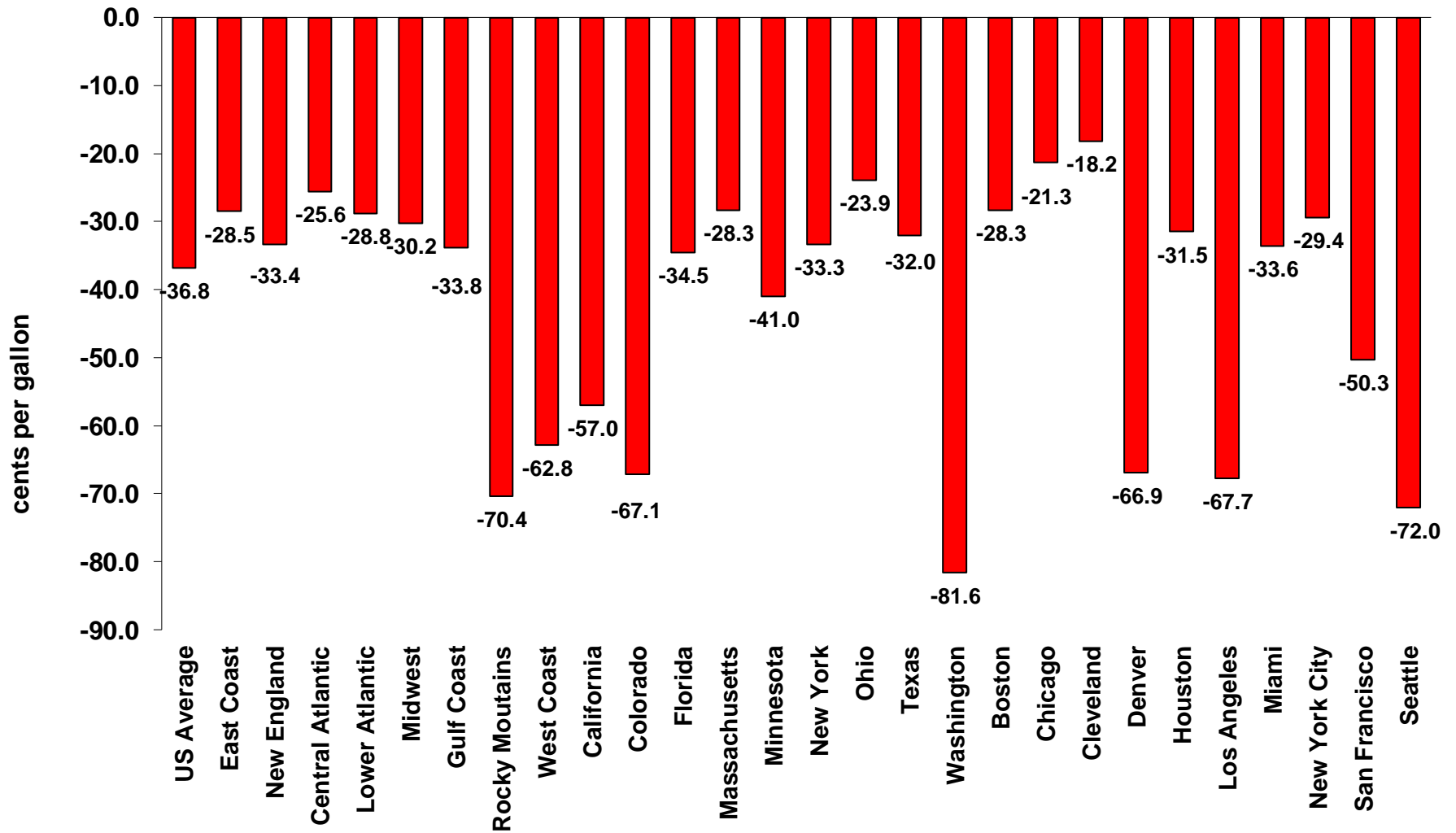
Figure 8: High, Low, and 2024 Current Week Prices

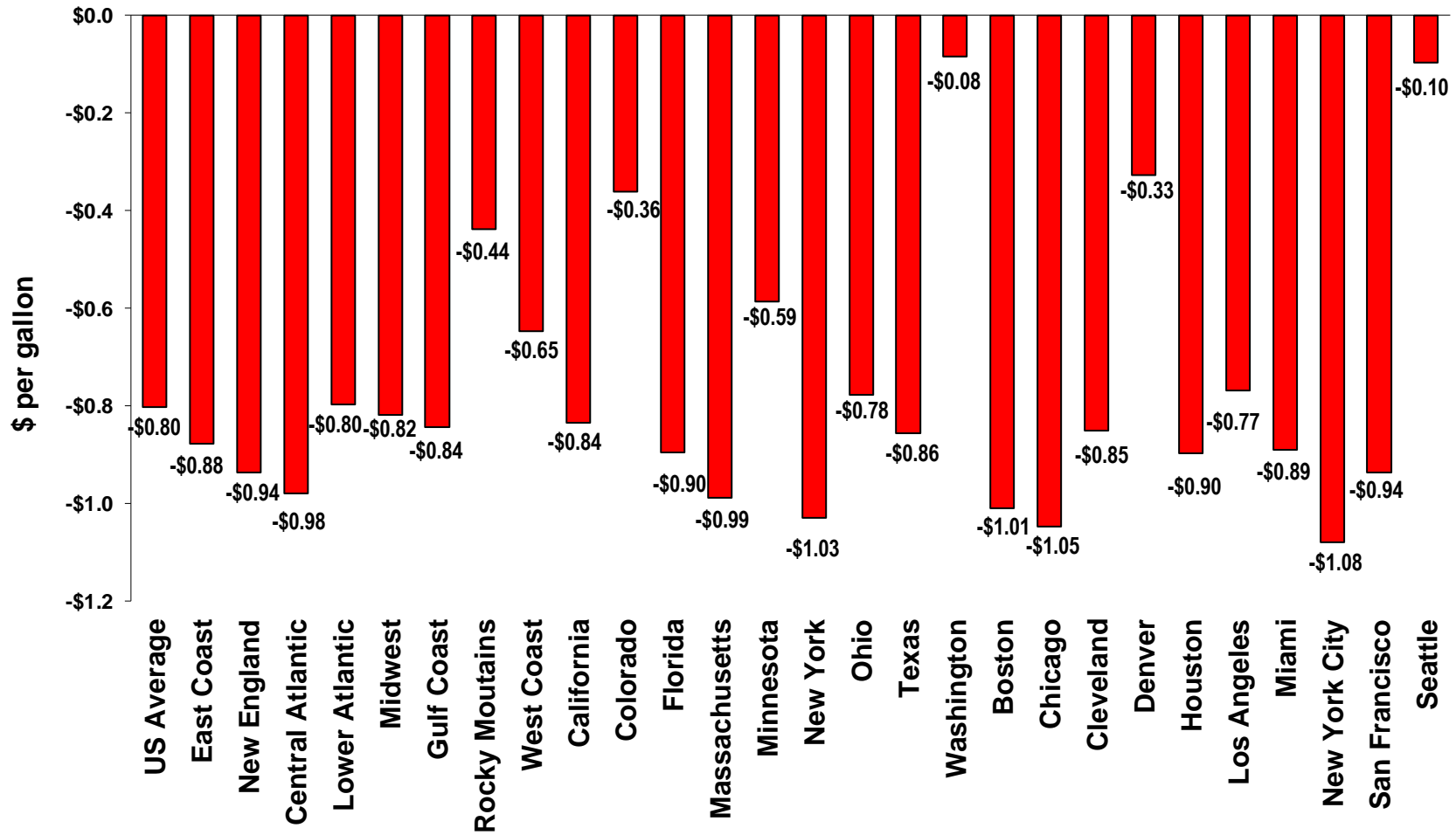
Figure 9: Change in Gasoline Prices Summer 2024: June 03, 2024 - June 24, 2024

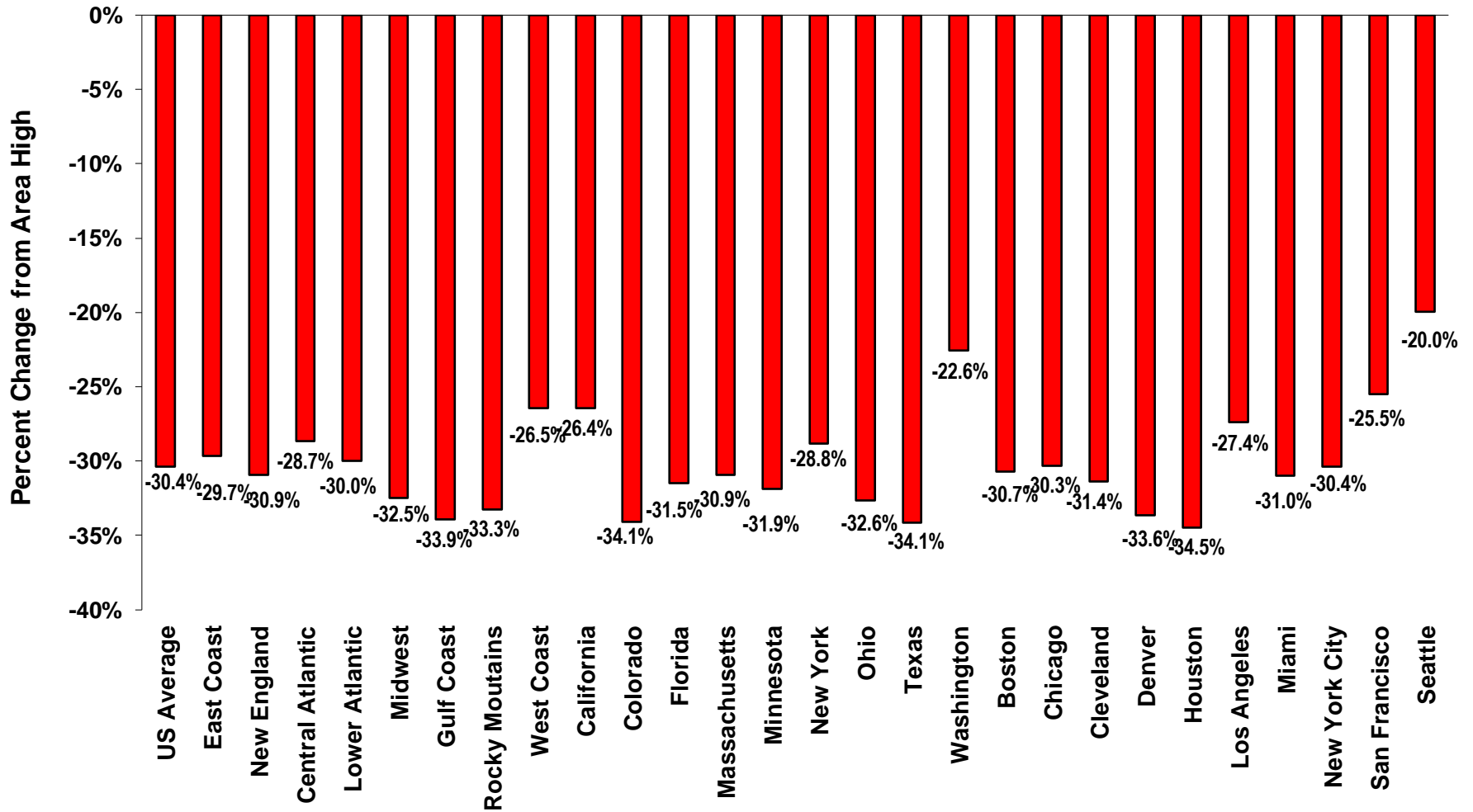
Figure 10: Change in Gasoline Prices Since Record High
